

Resolution 2011-35

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR AND SUBSEQUENT ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDS FROM ROUND 26 OF OPWC SMALL GOVERNMENTS FUNDING BY THE VILLAGE OF HIRAM, REPEALING RESOLUTION 2011-32 AND RATIFYING PAST ACTIONS WHICH ARE NOW AUTHORIZED IN THIS RESOLUTION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Hiram was initially an unsuccessful applicant in PY-12 Round 26 Public Works–District 7 Infrastructure grant; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the initial application the Portage County Engineer Michael Marozzi informed the village that the Small Government Committee indentified the village’s project as one to be recommended for funding; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Lou Bertrand, with the help of Dan Moss of the engineering firm of Burgess and Niple, has completed and submitted the application for grant funding prior to the deadline date of October 28, 2011.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two-thirds of the members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1: The actions of the Village administration and its consultants in applying to Ohio Public Works Commission for the grant to fund the SR305 Water Line Extension prior to the passage of this legislation from are hereby approved and ratified.

Section 2: The total of the project cost is \$286,400. The amount of the grant request is \$257,800. The matching portion of the grant would be \$28,600. The grant application is attached as Exhibit “A.”


Section 3: In the event that the grant is awarded to the Village, the Mayor and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Ohio Public Works Commission in substantial conformity with the terms set forth in the Grant Application attached as Exhibit “A”.

Section 4: In the event the grant is awarded the Village of Hiram, the Council of the Village hereby authorizes the Fiscal Officer to accept grant funds from Ohio Public Works Commission.


Section 5: This Resolution is declared an emergency measure becoming effective immediately upon its passage, to advance the health, safety and general welfare of the Village of Hiram, and for the further reason that the deadline to apply for the grant funds as is set forth in the grant application, predated the opportunity of the Village Council to be informed of the grant process.

Section 6: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in open meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


