

RESOLUTION 2016-18

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE 2017 PROPOSED BUDGET AND AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO SUBMIT THE BUDGET TO THE PORTAGE COUNTY AUDITOR.**

**WHEREAS**, the 2017 budget projections for the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio must be submitted to the County Auditor by July 20, 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, a Public Hearing must be held prior to the submission of the budget to the County Auditor; and

**WHEREAS**, said hearing was held on June 14, 2016 thirty minutes prior to the start of the regular monthly Council meeting.


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, a majority or more of the members thereto concurring that:

**SECTION 1:** Hiram Village Council hereby approves the 2017 budget, said approval having been given in light of the discussion of the budget at the public hearing and during Council meetings; and instructs the Fiscal Officer to send two copies of the 2017 budget to the County Auditor prior to July 20, 2016.


**SECTION 2:** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.


