

RESOLUTION 2016-23

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH GAMETIME FOR PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Hiram has previously determined that it is in the public interest to support the efforts of the Village Park Board to establish a park in the Village; and

WHEREAS, in order to pay for improvements to the park, the Village of Hiram Park Board has applied for and has been awarded various grants to pay for improvements to the park; and

WHEREAS, the Park Board has recommended that a playground be installed in the park, and has recommended approval of the attached quote from GameTime for the installation of a playground; and

WHEREAS, the quote from GameTime was obtained through US Communities, an organization which competitively bids various products nationwide, and the Village Solicitor has concluded that a purchase of the GameTime playground equipment through US Communities complies with the competitive bidding requirements of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, the Park Board represents that the total cost of the new public improvements are less than \$250,000.00, and as such is not subject to prevailing wage requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Hiram wishes to authorize the Mayor and the Fiscal Officer to enter into a contract with GameTime to supply and install playground equipment at the Village Park.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Hiram, Portage County, Ohio, two thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:

Section 1: In reliance upon the representation of the Park Board that the total cost of the new public improvement is less than \$250,000.00, the Council finds that work at the Village Park is not subject to prevailing wage requirements.

Section 2: The Mayor and the Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with GameTime for the purchase and installation of playground equipment at the Village Park, in substantial conformity with the document attached hereto and marked for identification as Exhibit "A".

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that the deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
